EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR RECRUITMENT OF CONSTRUCTION SUPERVISION CONSULTANTS

The Govt. of India (hereinafter called the "Borrower") has applied for a loan from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) for Financing of Bihar State Highways IV Project (BSHP-IV, Phase-1). Under BSHP-IV, Phase-1, Five (05) Road Projects, about 225.48 km is proposed to be taken up for rehabilitation/upgradation/strengthening & widening. Bihar State Road Development Corporation Limited (BSRDCL) is the Executing Agency for BSHP-IV, Phase-1. It is intended to utilise a portion of the funds for eligible payments under the contract for Construction Supervision Consultant/Project Management & Authority Engineer in two packages as under:-

Consultancy Services is for (i) Construction Supervision/ Project Management & Authority Engineer (ii) Monitoring and Evaluating, using criteria of the project performance management system with focus on social impacts; and (iii) Environmental Management including monitoring of implementation of the mitigation measures to the adverse impacts to the environment, in accordance with ADB's Safeguard Policies.

An initial input for 2 months is expected prior to the start of the Civil Works, duration of Civil Works and intermittent input during the defect notification period of 36 months for supervision consultancy services and 60 Months DLP/Maintenance period for Project Management Authority Engineering services. For Package -1, the input of the National Expert including sub key professional is estimated at 2112 person-months and for Package -2, the input of National Experts including sub key professional is estimated to be 744 person-months. The Estimated Budget for Consultancy services is about US\$ 6.197 million for Package-1 and US\$ 3.316 million for Package-2.

BSRDCL now invites eligible National/ International Supervision Consulting Firms to express their interest in providing the services. Firms should be from ADB member Country. Consulting Firms/ Organization having proven experience in Project Supervision Consultancy Services for Externally Aided Major Road Project may kindly send their "Expression of Interest". Not more than 6 consultancy firms shall be shortlisted for each package.

On the basis of submission, the firms shall be shortlisted and invited to submit their proposals, in accordance with ADB's Guidelines i.e. ADB Procurement Policy: Goods, Works, Non consulting and Consulting Services (2017, as amended from time to time); and the Procurement Regulations for ADB

Borrowers: Goods, Works, Non consulting and Consulting Services (2017, as amended from time to time). The Request for Proposal to the shortlisted firms is expected to be issued in January, 2025. Selection of the Consultant shall be done under QCBS (Quality and Cost Based Selection, 80:20 ratio) (Full Technical Proposal) in accordance with the ADB Guidelines. In evaluation, Additional weightage will be given to the firm having experience of projects being funded by Multilateral Development Bank and being implemented in similar geographical area. The project executed in Indian region may likely to be considered under similar geographical area.

A Qualifying Project shall be taken as one, in which the Consultancy fees is more than or equal to US\$ 3.5 Million and In case of JV member Consultancy fees shall be US\$ 2.0 Million. The qualifying project shall not be more than Five years from the date of submission of EOI and shall be updated @ of 5% yearly from bid due date. Conversion rate shall be taken as RBI selling rate 28 days before the date of submission of EOI. Only those projects shall be considered for evaluation which have been substantially (90% or more with the completion to fulfil the intended purpose of the Project) completed and shall be supported by certificate from the Principal Employer.

Completed /substantially completed Highway /Bridge /Elevated/Flyover project executed on the following mode shall only be considered as a qualifying project-

- i. Item Rate Contract (remeasurement, measure and pay)
- ii. EPC Contract

In the case of Joint Ventures/Associates EOIs, the weightage for the Lead firm- 80% and for the JV/Associate-20% shall be taken for the evaluation purposes. Consulting firm has to declare the intension to form JV/ Associate at the time of EOI. Shortlisted bidders will not be allowed to make any changes with regards to JV/Associates while submitting RFP.

The bidding firm should have sound financial background. Consultancy firm should be profitable entity i.e. Profit after tax should be positive in each of the last 3 financial year. Financial soundness of the firm should be supported by audited financial reports including profit and loss statement, Current asset and liability and fixed asset and liability in the last 3 year. In case of JV, financial soundness is to be satisfied by all JV member.

Simultaneous to this invitation, a Consulting Services Recruitment Notice (CSRN) is published on ADB's website. The website includes a link to standard expression of interest (EOI) form that firms can download, filled out and submit online through ADB's via the ADB's Consultant Management System (CMS).

For online submission: (1) register with ADB's CMS (Consultant Management System) at <http://cms.adb.org> (2) go to <http://csrns.adb.org> (3) Click on "INDIA" (4) find the captioned Project Name and click on "view" (5) click on submit "EOI" and (6) follow the instructions. All requested information must be filled in completely.

A firm wishing to submit an EOI must be registered with the CMS. Any proposed associate firms, sub consultants, or joint venture partners must also be registered with CMS. Any firm encountering technical problems in accessing CMS should request assistance by email to cmshelp@adb.org. Firms are recommended to update their CMS registration before commencing their EOI.
