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Α. General

Scope of Bid 1.1 In connection with the Invitation for Bids (IFB) indicated in the Bid Data 1. Sheet (BDS), the Employer, as indicated in the BDS, issues this Bidding Document for the procurement of Works as specified in Section 6 (Employer's Requirements). The name, identification, and number of contracts of the open competitive bidding (OCB) are provided in the BDS. 1.2 Throughout this Bidding Document, (a) the term "in writing" means communicated in written form and delivered against receipt; (b) except where the context requires otherwise, words indicating the singular also include the plural and words indicating the plural also include the singular; and (C) "day" means calendar day. The Borrower or Recipient (hereinafter called "Borrower") indicated in the 2. Source of Funds 2.1 BDS has applied for or received financing (hereinaft, colled "funds") from the Asian Development Bank (hereinafter called "LDD") toward the cost of the project named in the BDS. The Borrower intend to apply a portion of the funds to eligible payments under the converts) for which this Bidding Document is issued. Payments by the ADB will be made only at the request of the Borrower and 2.2 upon approval by ADB in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Financing Agreement between he Borrower and ADB (hereinafter called "Financing Agreement"), and will be subject in all respects to the terms and conditions of that Finan ing Agreement. No party other than the Borrower shall derive any rights from the Financing Agreement or have any claim to the funds. ADB's Anticon vition Policy (1998, as amended to date) requires Borrowers 3. Fraud and 3.1 Corruption (including Deneficiaries of ADB-financed activity), as well as Bidders, Suppliers, nd Contractors under ADB-financed contracts, observe the highest standard or ethics during the procurement and execution of such contracts. In pursuance of this policy, ADB Jot to be used as a Bid defines, for the purposes of this provision, the terms set forth below as follows: (i) "corrupt practice" means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting, directly or indirectly, anything of value to influence improperly the actions of another party; (ii) "fraudulent practice" means any act or omission, including a misrepresentation, that knowingly or recklessly misleads, or attempts to mislead, a party to obtain a financial or other benefit or to avoid an obligation; (iii) "coercive practice" means impairing or harming, or threatening to impair or harm, directly or indirectly, any party or the property of the party to influence improperly the actions of a party; (iv) "collusive practice" means an arrangement between two or more parties designed to achieve an improper purpose, including influencing improperly the actions of another party;

- (v) "abuse" means theft, waste, or improper use of assets related to ADB-related activity, either committed intentionally or through reckless disregard;
- (vi) "conflict of interest" means any situation in which a party has interests that could improperly influence that party's performance of official duties or responsibilities, contractual obligations, or compliance with applicable laws and regulations;
- (vii) "obstructive practice" means (a) deliberately destroying, falsifying, altering, or concealing of evidence material to an ADB investigation, or deliberately making false statements to investigators, with the intent to impede an ADB investigation; (b) threatening, harassing, or intimidating any party to prevent it from disclosing its knowledge of matters relevant to a B., k investigation or from pursuing the investigation; or (c) deliberate acts intended to impede the exercise of ADB's contraction' rights of audit or inspection or access to information; and
- (viii) "integrity violation" is any act, as defined under ADB's Integrity Principles and Guidelines (2015, as amended from time to time), which violates ADB's Anticorruption Policy arcluding (i) to (vii) above and the following: violations of ADD's sanctions, retaliation against whistleblowers or witnesses, and other violations of ADB's Anticorruption Policy, including failure to adhere to the highest ethical standard.
- (b) will reject a proposal for award it determines that the Bidder recommended for award has, divery or through an agent, engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, coercive, or obstructive practices or other integrity violations in competing for the Contract;
- (c) will cancel the portion of the financing allocated to a contract if it determines at any time that representatives of the Borrower or of a beneficiary of ADP-financing engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, coercive, or ob-tractive practices or other integrity violations during the procurement of the execution of that contract, without the Borrower having taken amely and appropriate action satisfactory to ADB to remedy the situation;
- (d) till mpose remedial actions on a firm or an individual, at any time, in accordance with ADB's Anticorruption Policy and Integrity Principles and Guidelines, including declaring ineligible, either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, to participate¹ in ADB-financed, -administered, or -supported activities or to benefit from an ADB-financed, -administered, or -supported contract, financially or otherwise, if it at any time determines that the firm or individual has, directly or through an agent, engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, coercive, or obstructive practices or other integrity violations; and
- (e) will have the right to require that a provision be included in bidding documents and in contracts financed by ADB, requiring Bidders, suppliers and contractors to permit ADB or its representative to inspect

their accounts and records and other documents relating to the bid submission and contract performance and to have them audited by auditors appointed by ADB.

- 3.2 All Bidders, consultants, contractors, suppliers, and other third parties engaged or involved in ADB-related activities have a duty to cooperate fully in any screening or investigation when requested by ADB to do so. Such cooperation includes, but is not limited to, the following:
 - (a) being available to be interviewed and replying fully and truthfully to all questions asked;
 - (b) providing ADB with any items requested that are within the party's control including, but not limited to, documents and other physical objects;
 - (c) upon written request by ADB, authorizing other related entities of release directly to ADB such information that is specifically and materially related, directly or indirectly, to the said entities or issues which are the subject of the investigation;
 - (d) cooperating with all reasonable requests to search or physically inspect their person and/or work areas, including files electronic databases, and personal property used on ADB activities, or that utilizes ADB's Information and Communications Technology (ICT) resources or systems (including mobile phones, person a electronic devices, and electronic storage devices such as external a k drives);
 - (e) cooperating in any testing to us sted by ADB, including but not limited to, fingerprint identification, handwriting analysis, and physical examination and analysis, and
 - (f) preserving and protecting confidentiality of all information discussed with, and as required by, ADB.
- 3.3 All Bidder Consultants, contractors and suppliers shall ensure that, in its contract with its sub-consultants, Subcontractors, and other third parties engaged or involved in ADB-related activities, such sub-consultants, Subcontractors, and other third parties similarly undertake the foregoing duty to cooperate fully in any screening or investigation when requested by ADB to io so.

The Employer hereby puts the Bidder on notice that the Bidder or any Joint Venture partner of the Bidder (if any) may not be able to receive any payments under the Contract if the Bidder or any of its Joint Venture partners, as appropriate, is, or is owned (in whole or in part) by a person or entity subject to applicable sanctions.

- 3.5 Furthermore, Bidders shall be aware of the provision stated in Subclause 1.15 and 15.6 of the Conditions of Contract.
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 - 4.1 A Bidder may be a natural person, private entity, or government-owned enterprise subject to ITB 4.5—or any combination of them with a formal

intent to enter into an agreement or under an existing agreement in the form of a Joint Venture. In the case of a Joint Venture,

- (a) all partners shall be jointly and severally liable; and
- (b) the Joint Venture shall nominate a Representative who shall have the authority to conduct all business for and on behalf of any and all the parties of the Joint Venture during the bidding process and, in the event the Joint Venture is awarded the Contract, during contract execution.
- 4.2 A Bidder, and all parties constituting the Bidder, shall have the nationality of an eligible country, in accordance with Section 5 (Eligible Countries). A Bidder shall be deemed to have the nationality of a country if the Bidder is a citizen or is constituted, incorporated, or registered, and operates in conformity with the provisions of the laws of that country. This criterion shall also apply to the determination of the nationality of proposed Subcontractors or Suppliers for any part of the Contract including related services.
- 4.3 A Bidder shall not have a conflict of interest. All Bidders found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified. A Bidder may be considered to be in a conflict of interest with one or more parties in the bidding process if any of, including but not limited to, the following apply:
 - (a) they have controlling shareholders in common; or
 - (b) they receive or have received any direct or indirect subsidy from any of them; or
 - (c) they have the same legal representative for purposes of this bid; or
 - (d) they have a relationship with each other, directly or through common third parties, that puts the n it a position to have access to material information about or improperty influence the bid of another Bidder, or influence the decisions of the Employer regarding this bidding process; or
 - (e) a Bidder participate in more than one bid in this bidding process, either individually or a a partner in a Joint Venture, except for alternative offers permitted under ITB 13 of the Bidding Document. This will result in the disquerification of all Bids in which it is involved. However, subject why finding of a conflict of interest in terms of ITB 4.3(a)-(d) above this does not limit the participation of a Bidder as a Subcontractor in another Bid or of a firm as a Subcontractor in more than one Bid; or
 - affiliated entity, participated as a Consultant in the preparation of the design or technical specifications of the works that are the subject of the Bid; or
 - (g) a Bidder was affiliated with a firm or entity that has been hired (or is proposed to be hired) by the Employer or Borrower as Engineer for the contract; or
 - (h) a Bidder would be providing goods, works, or nonconsulting services resulting from or directly related to consulting services for the preparation or implementation of the project specified in the BDS ITB 2.1 that it provided or were provided by any affiliate that directly or indirectly controls, is controlled by, or is under common control with that firm.

- 4.4 A firm shall not be eligible to participate in any procurement activities under an ADB-financed, -administered, or -supported project while under temporary suspension or debarment by ADB pursuant to its Anticorruption Policy (see ITB 3), whether such debarment was directly imposed by ADB, or enforced by ADB pursuant to the Agreement for Mutual Enforcement of Debarment Decisions. A bid from a temporary suspended or debarred firm will be rejected.
- 4.5 Government-owned enterprises in the Employer's country shall be eligible only if they can establish that they (i) are legally and financially autonomous, (ii) operate under commercial law, and (iii) are not a dependent agency of the Employer.
- 4.6 A Bidder shall not be under suspension from bidding by the Employer as the result of the execution of a Bid-Securing Declaration.
- Bidders shall provide such evidence of their continued eligibility substactory 4.7 to the Employer, as the Employer shall reasonably request.
- Firms shall be excluded if by an act of compliance with 6 decision of the 4.8 United Nations Security Council taken under Chapter VI of the Charter of the United Nations, the Borrower's country prohibits my import of goods or contracting of works or services from that courtry of any payments to persons or entities in that country.
- 4.9 In case a prequalification process has och conducted prior to the bidding process, this bidding is open only to proqualified Bidders.
- The materials, equipment, and services to be supplied under the Contract shall **Eligible Materials**, 5.1 have their origin in eligible source countries as defined in ITB 4.2, and all Equipment and expenditures under the Contract will be limited to such materials, equipment, and services. At the Employer's request, Bidders may be required to provide evidence of the origin f materials, equipment, and services.
 - For purposes of 2B 5.1 above, "origin" means the place where the materials 5.2 and equipment are mined, grown, produced, or manufactured, and from which the services are provided. Materials and equipment are produced when, throu n manufacturing, processing, or substantial or major assembling of components, a commercially recognized product results that differs substantially in its basic characteristics or in purpose or utility from its components.

- 6.2 The IFB issued by the Employer is not part of the Bidding Document.
- **6.3** The Employer is not responsible for the completeness of the Bidding Document and their addenda, if they were not obtained directly from the source stated by the Employer in the IFB.
- 6.4 The Bidder is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms, and specifications in the Bidding Document. Failure to furnish all information or documentation required by the Bidding Document may result in the rejection of the bid.
- 7.1 A prospective Bidder requiring any clarification on the Bidding Document shall contact the Employer in writing at the Employer's address indicated in the BDS or raise his inquiries during the pre-bid meetine of provided for in accordance with ITB 7.4. The Employer will respond in the final transformer of the deadline for submission of bids. The Employer shall forward copies of its response to all Bidders who have acquired the Bidding Document in accordance with ITB 6.3, including a description of the inquiry but without identifying its source. Should the Employer deem it necessary to amend the Bidding Document as a result of a request for clarification, it shall do so following the procedure under ITP 8, and ITB 22.2.
 - 7.2 The Bidder is advised to visit and examine the Site of Works and its surroundings and obtain for it. If on its own responsibility all information that may be necessary for preparing the Bid and entering into a contract for construction of the Werks. The costs of visiting the Site shall be at the Bidder's own expense.
 - 7.3 The Bidder and any of its personnel or agents will be granted permission by the Employer to enter its premises and lands for the purpose of such visit, but only not the express condition that the Bidder, its personnel, and agents will release and indemnify the Employer and its personnel and agents from and against all liability in respect thereof, and will be responsible for death or personal injury, loss of or damage to property, and any other loss, damage, costs, and expenses incurred as a result of the inspection.
 - 4 The Bidder's designated representative is invited to attend a pre-bid meeting, if provided for in the BDS. The purpose of the meeting will be to clarify issues and to answer questions on any matter that may be raised at that stage.
 - 7.5 The Bidder is requested to submit any questions in writing, to reach the Employer not later than 1 week before the meeting.
 - 7.6 Minutes of the pre-bid meeting, including the text of the questions raised, without identifying the source, and the responses given, together with any responses prepared after the meeting, will be transmitted promptly to all

Bidders who have acquired the Bidding Document in accordance with ITB 6.3. - 11.1 The Bid stall comprise two envelopes submitted simultaneously, one called the T chincal Bid containing the documents listed in ITB 11.2 and the other the P ice Bid containing the documents listed in ITB 11.3, both envelopes enclosed together in an outer single envelope.

- 11.4 In addition to the requirements under ITB 11.2, Bids submitted by a Joint Venture shall include a copy of the Joint Venture Agreement entered into by all partners. Alternatively, a Letter of Intent to execute a Joint Venture Agreement in the event of a successful Bid shall be signed by all partners and submitted with the Bid, together with a copy of the proposed agreement.
- 12.1 The Letters of Technical Bid and Price Bid, and the Schedules, including the 12. Letters of Bid and Schedules Bill of Quantities, shall be prepared using the relevant forms, punshed in Section 4 (Bidding Forms). The forms must be completed without any alterations to the text, and no substitutes shall be accepted will blank spaces shall be filled in with the information requested and as repired in the BDS.
 - 13.1 Unless otherwise indicated in the BDS, alternative Bids shall not be considered.
 - 13.2 When alternative times for completion are explicitly invited, a statement to that effect will be included in the BDS, is will the method of evaluating different times for completion.
 - 13.3 Except as provided under ITB 13.- below, Bidders wishing to offer technical alternatives to the requirements of the Bidding Document must first price the Employer's design as de cibed in the Bidding Document and shall further provide all information accessary for a complete evaluation of the alternative by the Employer Chcluding drawings, design calculations, technical specifications, breatdown of prices, and proposed construction methodology and other relevant details. Only the technical alternatives, if any, of the lowest evaluated Picker conforming to the basic technical requirements shall be considered by the Employer.
 - 13.4 When specified in the BDS, Bidders are permitted to submit alternative termical solutions for specified parts of the Works. Such parts will be dentified in the BDS and described in Section 6 (Employer's Requirements). The method for their evaluation will be stipulated in Section 3 (Evaluation and Qualification Criteria).
 - 14.1 The prices and discounts quoted by the Bidder in the Letter of Price Bid and in the Bill of Quantities shall conform to the requirements specified below.
 - 14.2 The Bidder shall fill in rates and prices for all items of the Works described in the Bill of Quantities. Items against which no rate or price is entered by the Bidder will not be paid for by the Employer when executed and shall be deemed covered by the rates for other items and prices in the Bill of Ouantities.

- 14.3 The price to be quoted in the Letter of Price Bid, in accordance with ITB 12.1, shall be the total price of the Bid, excluding any discounts offered. Absence of the total bid price in the Letter of Price Bid may result in the rejection of the Bid.
- 14.4 The Bidder shall quote any discounts and the methodology for their application in the Letter of Price Bid, in accordance with ITB 12.1.
- 14.5 The prices shall be either fixed or adjustable as specified in the BDS.
 - (a) In the case of Fixed Price, prices quoted by the Bidder shall be fixed during the Bidder's performance of the contract and not subject to variation on any account. A Bid submitted with an adjustable price will be treated as nonresponsive and rejected.
 - (b) In the case of Adjustable Price, prices quoted by the Bidder shall be subject to adjustment during performance of the contract or reflect changes in the cost elements such as labor, material, the sport, and contractor's equipment in accordance with the provisions of the Conditions of Contract. A Bid submitted with a fixed proceed will be treated as nonresponsive and be rejected. The Bidder shall furnish the indexes and weightings for the price adjustment formulas in the Tables of Adjustment Data included in Section 4 (Pidding Forms) and the Employer may require the Bidder to jugary its proposed indexes and weightings. Any bid that omits indexes and weightings shall be subject to clarification with the Bidder.
- 14.6 If so indicated in ITB 1.1, bids are teing invited for individual contracts or for any combination of contracts (n. ckages). Bidders wishing to offer any price reduction for the award of more than one Contract shall specify in their bid the price reductions applical le b each package, or alternatively, to individual Contracts within the package. Price reductions or discounts shall be submitted in accordance with ¹C 14.4, provided the Bids for all contracts are submitted and opened at the s me time.
- 14.7 All duties, t. ves, and other levies payable by the Contractor under the Contract or for any other cause, as of the date 28 days prior to the deadline for submission of bids, shall be included in the rates and prices and the total Bic price submitted by the Bidder.
- 15. Currencies of Bid and Payment
- The unit rates and the prices shall be quoted by the Bidder entirely in the currency specified in the BDS.
- **15.2** Bidders shall indicate the portion of the bid price that corresponds to expenditures incurred in the currency of the Employer's country in the Schedule of Payment Currencies included in Section 4 (Bidding Forms).
- **15.3** Bidders expecting to incur expenditures in other currencies for inputs to the Works supplied from outside the Employer's country and wishing to be paid accordingly may indicate the other currencies in the Schedule of Payment Currencies included in Section 4 (Bidding Forms).
- 15.4 The rates of exchange to be used by the Bidder for currency conversion during bid preparation shall be the selling rates for similar transactions prevailing on

the date 28 days prior to the deadline for submission of bids published by the source specified in the BDS. If exchange rates are not so published for certain currencies, the Bidder shall state the rates used and the source. Bidders should note that for the purpose of payments, the exchange rates confirmed by the source specified in the BDS as the selling rates prevailing 28 days prior to the deadline for submission of Bids shall apply for the duration of the Contract so that no currency exchange risk is borne by the Bidder.

- **15.5** Foreign currency requirements indicated by the Bidders in the Schedule of Payment Currencies shall include but not limited to the specific requirements for
 - (a) expatriate staff and labor employed directly on the Works;
 - (b) social, insurance, medical and other charges relating to such expatriate staff and labor, and foreign travel expenses;
 - (c) imported materials, both temporary and permanent, including fuels, oil and lubricants required for the Works;
 - (d) depreciation and usage of imported Plant and Contractor's pruipment, including spare parts, required for the Works;
 - (e) foreign insurance and freight charges for imported nationals, Plant and Contractor's Equipment, including spare parts; and
 - (f) overhead expenses, fees, profit, and financial charges arising outside the Employer's country in connection with the Works.
- **15.6** Bidders may be required by the Employer to clarify their foreign currency requirements, and to substantiate that the mounts included in the unit rates and prices and shown in the Schedule or Payment Currencies are reasonable and responsive to ITB 15.3 above, n which case a detailed breakdown of its foreign currency requirements shall be provided by the Bidder.
- 15.7 Bidders should note the Curing the progress of the Works, the foreign currency requirements of the outstanding balance of the Contract Price may be adjusted by agreem in between the Employer and the Contractor in order to reflect any change in foreign currency requirements for the Contract, in accordance with Subclause 14.15 of the Conditions of Contract. Any such adjustment should be effected by comparing the percentages quoted in the bid with the and unts already used in the Works and the Contractor's future needs for im, or ed items.
- 16.1 The Bidder shall furnish a Technical Proposal including a statement of work nethods, equipment, personnel, schedule, and any other information as stipulated in Section 4 (Bidding Forms), in sufficient detail to demonstrate the adequacy of the Bidders' proposal to meet the work requirements and the completion time.
- 17.1 To establish its qualifications to perform the Contract in accordance with Section 3 (Evaluation and Qualification Criteria) the Bidder shall provide the information requested in the corresponding information sheets included in Section 4 (Bidding Forms).
- **17.2** Domestic Bidders, individually or in Joint Ventures, applying for eligibility for domestic preference shall supply all information required to satisfy the

- 21.5 If all envelopes are not scaled and marked as required, the Employer will assume no responsibility for the misplacement or premature opening of the Bid.
- 22.1 Bids must be needed by the Employer at the address and no later than the date and time indicated in the BDS.
- The Imployer may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of 22.2 Bills by amending the Bidding Document in accordance with ITB 8, in which case all rights and obligations of the Employer and Bidders previously subject to the deadline shall thereafter be subject to the deadline as extended.
- 23.1 The Employer shall not consider any Bid that arrives after the deadline for submission of bids, in accordance with ITB 22. Any bid received by the Employer after the deadline for submission of Bids shall be declared late, rejected, and returned unopened to the Bidder.
- 24.1 A Bidder may withdraw, substitute, or modify its Bid Technical or Price after it has been submitted by sending a written notice, duly signed by an authorized representative, and shall include a copy of the authorization in accordance with ITB 20.2 (except for withdrawal notices, which do not require copies). The corresponding substitution or modification of the Bid must accompany the respective written notice. All notices must be

E. Evaluation and Comparison of Bids

Confidentiality26.1 Information relating to the examination, evaluation, comparison, and postqualification of Bids and recommendation of contract award, shall not be disclosed to Bidders or any other persons not officially concerned with such process until information on the Contract award is communicated to all Bidders.
 - 26.2 Any attempt by a Bidder to influence the Employer in the evaluation of the Bids or Contract award decisions may result in the rejection of its 2d.
 - 26.3 Notwithstanding ITB 26.2, from the time of bid open is the time of Contract award, if any Bidder wishes to contact the Employer on any matter related to the bidding process, it may do so in writin.
- 27. Clarification of Bids 27.1 To assist in the examination, evaluation, and comparison of the Technical and Price Bids, the Employer may, at its discretion, ask any Bidder for a clarification of its Bid. Any clarification submitted by a Bidder that is not in response to a request by the Employer shall not be considered. The Employer's request for clarification and the response shall be in writing. No change in the substance of the Technical Bid or prices in the Price Bid shall be sought, offered, or permitted, except to confirm the correction of arithmetic errors discovered by the Employer in the evaluation of the Price Bids, in accordance with ITB 32.
 - 27.2 If a Bidder doer not provide clarifications of its Bid by the date and time set in the Employee's request for clarification, its Bid may be rejected.
 - 28.1 Durit 9 the evaluation of Bids, the following definitions apply:

Deviation" is a departure from the requirements specified in the Bidding Document;

- (b) "Reservation" is the setting of limiting conditions or withholding from complete acceptance of the requirements specified in the Bidding Document; and
- (c) "Omission" is the failure to submit part or all of the information or documentation required in the Bidding Document.
- **29.1** The Employer shall examine the Technical Bid to confirm that all documents and technical documentation requested in ITB 11.2 have been provided, and to determine the completeness of each document submitted.

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- **29.2** The Employer shall confirm that the following documents and information have been provided in the Technical Bid. If any of these documents or information is missing, the offer shall be rejected.

 - (c) Bid Security or Bid-Securing Declaration, if applicable; and
 - (d) Technical Proposal in accordance with ITB 16.
- **30.** Responsiveness of Technical Bid
- **30.1** The Employer's determination of a Bid's responsiveness is to be based on the contents of the bid itself, as defined in ITB11.
 - 30.2 A substantially responsive Technical Bid is one that meets the requirements of the Bidding Document without material deviation, reservation, or omission. A material deviation, reservation, or omission is one that,
 - (a) if accepted, would:

- (i) affect in any substantial way the scope, quality, or performance of the Works specified in the Contract; or
- (ii) limit in any substantial way, increasistent with the Bidding Document, the Employer's rig'ts or the Bidder's obligations under the proposed Contract; or
- (b) if rectified, would unfairly affec the competitive position of other Bidders presenting substantially re-ponsive Bids.
- **30.3** The Employer shall examine the technical aspects of the Bid submitted in accordance with ITB 16, Technical Proposal, in particular, to confirm that all requirements of Section t (F nployer's Requirements) have been met without any material deviation, reservation, or omission.
- 30.4 If a Bid is not outtantially responsive to the requirements of the Bidding Document, it chall be rejected by the Employer and may not subsequently be made responsive by correction of the material deviation, reservation, or omission
- 31.1 Pr vi led that a Bid is substantially responsive, the Employer may waive any no iconformities in the Bid that do not constitute a material deviation, reservation, or omission.
 - .2 Provided that a Technical Bid is substantially responsive, the Employer may request that the Bidder submit the necessary information or documentation, within a reasonable period of time, to rectify nonmaterial nonconformities in the Technical Bid related to documentation requirements. Requesting information or documentation on such nonconformities shall not be related to any aspect of the Price Bid. Failure of the Bidder to comply with the request may result in the rejection of its Bid.
- **31.** Nonmaterial Nonconformities

- **31.3** Provided that a Technical Bid is substantially responsive, the Employer shall rectify quantifiable nonmaterial nonconformities related to the Bid Price. To this effect, the Bid Price shall be adjusted, for comparison purposes only, to reflect the price of a missing or non-conforming item or component. The adjustment shall be made using the method indicated in Section 3 (Evaluation and Qualification Criteria).
- 32. Qualification of the 32.1 The Employer shall determine to its satisfaction during the evaluation of Bidder Technical Bids whether Bidders meet the qualifying criteria specified in Section 3 (Evaluation and Qualification Criteria).
 - **32.2** The determination shall be based upon an examination of the documentary evidence of the Bidder's qualifications submitted by the Bidder, pursuant to ITB 17.1. Unless permitted in the BDS, the determination shall not take into consideration the qualifications of other firms such as the Bidda's subsidiaries, parent entities, affiliates, Subcontractors (other than Specificity Subcontractors if permitted in ITB 33.2 of the Bidding document, or any other firm(s) different from the Bidder.

 - 37.4 If this Edding Document allows Bidders to quote separate prices for different contracts, and the award to a single Bidder of multiple contracts, the rethodology to determine the lowest evaluated price of the contract combinations, including any discounts offered in the Letter of Price Bid, is specified in Section 3 (Evaluation and Qualification Criteria).
 - **37.5** The Employer shall compare all substantially responsive Bids to determine the lowest evaluated Bid price, in accordance with ITB 37.2.
 - **38.1** An abnormally low bid is one where the bid price, in combination with other elements of the bid, appears to be so low that it raises concerns as to the capability of the Bidder to perform the contract for the offered bid price.
 - **38.2** When the offered bid price appears to be abnormally low, the Employer shall undertake a three-step review process as follows:
 - (a) identify abnormally low costs and unit rates by comparing them with the

engineer's estimates, other substantially responsive bids, or recently awarded similar contracts;

 - (a) accept the bid, if the evidence provided satisfactorily accounts for the low bid price and costs, in which case the bid is not consider a "Unormally low;
 - (b) accept the bid, but require that the amount of the performance security be increased at the expense of the bidder to a level of the increased the Employer against financial loss. The amount of the performance security shall generally be not more than 20% of the contract price; or
 - (c) reject the bid if the evidence provided dors not satisfactorily account for the low bid price, and make a similar determination for the next ranked bid, if required.
- **39.1** If the Bid, which results in the openion of the Employer, is seriously unbalanced or front-loaded in the opinion of the Employer, the Employer may require the Bidder to product detailed price analyses for any or all items of the Bill of Quantities, to dem in trate the internal consistency of those prices with the construction methods and schedule proposed, as well as the pricing and sources of material component and labor.
- **39.2** After the evaluation of the information and detailed price analyses presented by the Bidder, the Employer may as appropriate:
 - (a) a cert the Bid; or

(t) ccept the Bid, but require that the total amount of the Performance Security be increased at the expense of the Bidder to a level sufficient to protect the Employer against financial loss in the event of default of the successful Bidder under the Contract subject to ITB 45.2; or

(c) reject the Bid and make a similar determination for the next ranked bid.

40.1 The Employer reserves the right to accept or reject any Bid, and to annul the bidding process and reject all Bids at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to Bidders. In case of annulment, all Bids submitted and specifically, bid securities, shall be promptly returned to the Bidders.


